

MASONRY RUST REMOVER

Stone and Masonry Restorer

Description

Masonry Rust Remover is an acidic, heavy duty cleaner/restorer. It will remove a variety of contaminants from natural and man made stone surfaces. Rust Remover does not contain any bleach, abrasives, caustic, muriatic acid or petroleum distillates. It is formulated as a ready to use product and is generally used accordingly; however, it can be diluted for slightly contaminated surfaces.

Uses

Use Rust Remover to clean and restore stone, brick, masonry, concrete, travertine, marble (unpolished or unglazed), granite, limestone, stucco, terra-cotta and other similar type surfaces; removing stains, rust, chalking, efflorescence, atmospheric stains and dirt without etching, pitting or damaging the surface or grout.

Preparation

For best results, test a solution of Rust Remover before general use. It will damage and/or discolor glass, aluminum, polished and painted surfaces and colored grout. Keep away from plants and vegetation.

Application

Use Rust Remover full strength, do not dilute. Apply solution onto a dry surface, from the bottom up. Let solution stand for approximately 5-15 minutes, depending on surface and contaminants. Agitate and rinse thoroughly.

Packaged

Masonry Rust Remover is available in gallons (4/case), 5 gallon pails and 55 gallon drums.

Safety and Handling

For specific information, please refer to the material safety data sheet. Rust Remover is corrosive. Wear chemical resistant gloves, apron and goggles.

Storage and Shelf Life

The shelf life of Rust Remover is approximately 12 months in closed containers. Heat reduces the shelf life. Store in a cool, dry place.
