DESCRIPTION

StripIt® Neutralizer is an easy to use, environmentally friendly neutralizing agent that must be applied after using our StripIt Heavy Duty Alkaline Remover. It is imperative that StripIt® Neutralizer is used to reduce surface pH, even if the surface is not being painted after paint removal process is complete.

USES

Use StripIt® Neutralizer on interior and exterior surfaces including concrete, brick, stone, metal, wood, fiberglass and other similar surfaces. Wood surfaces will darken after using StripIt® Heavy Duty Alkaline Paint Remover on wood surfaces. Apply a solution of StripIt® Neutralizer to restore the natural color of wood surfaces.

PREPARATION

For best results and dilution ratio, test a solution following the directions on the container and test the surface pH before general use.

APPLICATION

After completely dissolving the granulars, apply liberally onto the surface. Let solution stand for approximately 10-20 minutes. Agitate surface using a stiff brush and rinse thoroughly. Test surface pH and reapply if necessary.

PACKAGED

Available in 1 pound packets, 8 pound jugs and 40 pound pails.

DISPOSAL

Use completely or dispose of properly. Local requirements vary. Consult your local sanitation department or state designated environmental agency.

Wash thoroughly after handling. **FIRST AID:** In case of eye contact, flush with water for 15 minutes. Get immediate medical attention. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water. If you experience difficulty breathing, leave the area to obtain fresh air. If continued difficulty is experienced, get medical attention immediately.
